Opening Times

Open 1st June - 30th September (inclusive). Book in advance or up to 8pm on the same day (subject to availability). Book through Pitchup.com and search our post code TF9 2QA

About Your Stay

We are a “**leave no trace**” campsite, respecting the environment around us – please note we cannot take your rubbish, but we do recycle you clean, washed out containers – both glass and plastic. Cardboard is also recycled.

Hints for “leave no trace” include, bringing food in Tupperware boxes, planning your meals ahead with lightweight snacks and minimum packaging.

Our shower/toilet block feeds into a Water Treatment System for all waste water. This requires bacteria to break down soap, toilet residue etc. **Please do not use any Anti Bacterial products**, as we will pollute the nearest lake. We supply suitable products for hand washing and showering. If your own products have the “safe for septic tank” message, then these are ideal.

Things to Do

- Relax, enjoy peace & quiet, listen to birdsong.
- Woodland walks (What3Words: *unwell.thighs.boots*).
- Walk to Loggerheads: pub, Co-op, Chinese takeaway, Indian restaurant.
- See piglets (seasonal).
- Local walks & pub lunches.

We do supply

- 40-pitch grass site with plenty of space. Each pitch is for up to 4 people only,
 - These include a new for 2026 “Backpackers Pitch for 2 people with a tent ”.
 - o – Bicycles, motor bikes, and hikers welcome on a Backpackers Pitch.

NO EHU available or Wifi on site.

• Facilities:

- Fresh water tap
- Grey water disposal point
- Elsan point with hose pipe

- Flushable toilets
 - Composting loos
 - Hot water wash up area
 - Showers
 - Supplied non antibacterial hand wash, and environmentally friendly shower gel
 - Recycling bins
 - Fridge Freezers for camp use
 - Recycle bins for glass, plastic and cardboard
- Quiet countryside setting next to an SSSI woodland (rare dormice, plants, butterflies).
 - Fire pits available from ourselves

Farm Shop

Open most mornings (08:00-08:30) and evenings (after 18:30).

We sell: Burgers, Frozen sausages, Bacon, Eggs, Semi-skimmed milk, Bread, Cereals.

Card payments accepted (subject to signal).

Extra Help

We can:

- Provide a barbecue on request for parties
- Charge phones/battery packs – hire a charging locker from ourselves
- Freeze icepacks overnight (collect during shop hours) if the camp fridge/freezer is full

We can't:

- Accept vehicles over 6m / caravans
- Allow loud music after 11pm – Loud guests will be asked to quieten down or leave.

Animals on the Farm

- Pigs: Behind an electric fence (do not touch or feed). Pig bites can be fatal.
- Horses: They bite, so please keep away and do not feed them.
- Calves, cows and bulls – do not enter their field, they are very protective.

Our Dog Policy

- Dogs are very welcome.
- Please pick up your dog poo or you will be asked to leave and pay £20
- There is a dog poo bin on site
- We have school children coming here regularly, and they do not need to treading in dog poo, hence we ask you keep the dog on a lead at all times. It may poo without you seeing it, and a child could get it on their hands.
- Please keep dogs on leads – not everyone likes a dog weeing up their tent or setting up their tent on dog poo
- KEEP DOGS away from the animals
- DOGS **can run free** in the woodland, but not on our land

Deposit Policy

£20 cash deposit on arrival, to be returned if all is well with your pitch when you leave.
